35 randomly selected schools (a 35% sample of all the schools supported by Water For People—India)

Type of school: **secondary**

Average number of students: **1097 per school**

Average number of latrines: **8 latrines for boys and 9 latrines for girls**

All of the schools had improved water systems that were constructed in 2008 - 09

*O&M Fund is money collected for Operation, Maintenance, Repair and Replacement costs that will be required to keep systems operational over time
